**College Admission Requirements:**

**Palliative Care Multidiscipline or Working with the Terminally Ill Multidiscipline Certificate**

applicants must have:

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent
- OR
- Mature Student status (19 years of age or older).

**Program Eligibility:**

Palliative Care Multidiscipline: Successful completion of the Orientation to Palliative Care course, which is the prerequisite to all other courses in the program.

Students are required to provide proof of successful completion of an approved diploma or degree program in the health or social service field.

Working with the Terminally Ill Multidiscipline: Proof of successful completion of an approved certificate program in health or social services field, or equivalent as assessed by the College. Volunteers working in palliative care and pastoral care are also considered for admission to the program;

Upon successful completion of NSG5627 Orientation to Palliative Care, interested students are asked to complete a program application form which must be submitted with the required documents.

**Certificate Requirements:** To be eligible to receive the Palliative Care Multidiscipline or Working with The Terminally Ill Multidiscipline Certificate, the student must complete all the courses listed in the Program of Study.

**FIELD PLACEMENT:**

Prior to clinical experience, students are required to complete an Algonquin College Health Assessment Form and/or an Immunization Form.

Agencies that allow the College access for the field placement may require students in this program to have a clear police records check.

To be eligible to participate in the field placement, you must submit proof of a clear police records check to the Program Department prior to the beginning of placement.

If you have been convicted of an offense under the criminal code for which you have not been pardoned, you may be unable to participate in the field placement. Successful completion of the field placement is a requirement for graduation.

If you register in the program and have a criminal record for which you have not received pardon, you must meet with the Departmental Chair prior to the first day of classes.

It is your responsibility to obtain this police records check from your local Police Department and to pay for any associated costs.
