Veterinary Assistant Program applicants must have:

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) or equivalent
Or
- Mature Student status (19 years of age or older).

And

- Attach to your application a document outlining; a) Any work experience in the veterinary field, identifying your responsibilities and skills performed. b) Your goals upon the successful completion of the Veterinary Assistant Certificate Program. **Maximum 250 words**

Accepted applicants must provide proof of Tetanus Vaccine. In addition, some field placements may require a pre-exposure rabies a vaccination, which is highly recommended for the program.

Certificate Requirements: To be eligible to receive the Veterinary Assistant Certificate, the student must successfully complete all the courses listed in the Program of Study and provide proof of basic computer and keyboarding skills.
