

Brantford Student Wins Algonquin College Entrance Bursary

Ottawa, Ont., March 29, 2004 – Algonquin College is pleased to announce that Brantford resident William D’Uva has won a \$500 bursary to attend the program of his choice at the College.

This year, Algonquin College made two bursaries available to any high school student who signed up online and then attended open house tours and activities during March Break at the College’s Woodroffe campus in Ottawa. Mr. D’Uva was one of about 100 students who took advantage of the opportunity to explore the post-secondary education options available at Ontario’s third largest College of Applied Arts and Technology.

“I was excited to win the bursary from Algonquin College,” said Mr. D’Uva, a Grade 12 student at St. John’s College in Brantford. “We enjoyed our tour of the College, the staff were friendly, and the facilities were impressive.” He plans to enter the three-year Business Administration program and live on campus.

The College facilities include several relatively new buildings including the Police and Public Safety Institute, School of Advanced Technology, and residence facilities for more than 1,000 students.
