The Residence is now managed by the College. Two groups are involved, Residence Services (Ancillary) and Residence Life (Student Support Services). Sedexho, a contract company, is responsible for maintenance, housekeeping and summer business.

The Mailbox Lobby, known as the “Student Life Lobby,” is the main hub for student services in the Residence. It is located on the far side of the main courtyard. Students must use a swipe card to access any parts of the Residence beyond the Front Desk lobby.

The Residence is home to diverse age groups and cultures. Within Residence, there are areas dedicated as “Alcohol Free” zones, and most lounges have themes, including an exercise room, movie lounge, and sports lounge. Students can also find lounges dedicated to study; some are for quiet, independent work, while others are for study groups.

- An academic advisor’s first point of contact about issues concerning students in Residence is Kim Dixon, Manager of Residence Life. She supports students academically and with issues of health and personal growth. She is a liaison to the rest of the College about the Residence
- All students in Residence have a “Resident Advisor” and an “Algonquin Residence Council” or ARC rep in their section.
- **RA’s** are upper year students who act as a front-line resource and support to the students.
- Danielle Puchnatyj is the Residence Life Coordinator and she is responsible for overseeing the Resident Advisors (20 of them) and the Senior Resident Advisor, Kristen Green.
- **ARC reps** act as the student voice and assist with event planning.
- Erika Monckton is the Residence Programmer and she is responsible for assisting the ARC reps as well as planning educational workshops.
