DINING LOCATIONS

The Marketplace Food Court is located in "D" Building. Here you will find a vast menu selection including vegetarian dishes, salad, items from the grill, Italian food, stir-fry, smoothies, frozen yogurt with fresh fruit, crêpes and subs. The Marketplace Food Court also features a patio for those nice summer days!

The 35th Street Market Café is located just inside the main doors to the Residence. The 35th Street Market Café offers a variety of grocery items, fresh fruits and vegetables, snacks, beverages, grab-and-go sandwiches and salads, fresh baked goods, made-to-order food concepts, health and beauty items, and more.

First Cup Deli is located in the lobby of "C" Building. Enjoy fresh-brewed coffee and baked goods at First Cup, or a hearty smoked meat sandwich at the Deli.

The Portable Feast is located on the main floor of "B" Building. It is a kiosk that offers a vast variety of foods such as pizza, Mexican burritos and fajitas, sandwiches, soup, and Spuds N' Stuff (baked potatoes loaded with whatever will satisfy your hunger). Light breakfast snacks are also available.

Thunder Alley is located in "A" Building. The menu features subs, desserts, soup, pizza and chili. Enjoy the pool tables or find a quiet study area. This facility also has a patio.

Bits n' Bytes is located in "T" Building. It offers a variety of freshly made salads, soups, baked goods, snacks, Panini sandwiches, Greek food and drinks.

TERM PLANS *(Save up to 18% on your meal purchase!)*

The **Light***, **Full*** and **Plus Plans*** are non-taxable under Government Tax regulations, which means you can save up to 18%. These tax savings apply to meal purchases only. They are also considered non-refundable. A minimum of \$900 must be used by the end of the purchased semester.

Light Plan* – One Semester: \$900 Full Year: \$1,800
Designed for students occasionally on campus weekends with average appetites. Valid for food purchases only. Not valid for toiletries. Save up to 18%.

Full Plan* – One Semester: \$1,250 Full Year: \$2,500
Our most popular plan, designed for students on campus alternate weekends and those with average appetites. \$100 is allocated to the Freedom Plan for non-food purchases. Save up to 18%.

Plus Plan* – One Semester: \$1,600 Full Year: \$3,200
Designed for students on campus most weekends, athletes and those with healthy appetites. \$100 is allocated to Freedom Plan for non-food purchases. Save up to 18%.

The Campus Plan

This plan is accepted at any location on Campus. It can be set up with a \$400 payment. You will save 5% on all purchases. You may add money to this plan in increments of \$100. Any unused monies will be forwarded to the next semester. Ideal for full and part-time students living off-campus. Taxes are applicable on all purchases.

The Freedom Plan

The Freedom Plan offers you the convenience of purchasing food without the hassle of carrying cash. The plan can be set up with an initial payment of \$100 and you can add money in increments of \$100 whenever you need to. Taxes are applicable on all purchases.
