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Parking Rules and Regulations (short form)

A Parking Permit is **not a guarantee that a space is available**; however, both Municipal and College Bylaw Enforcement Services will use reasonable means to prevent unauthorized parking by non-permit holders. If you forget your permit you can obtain a day pass through the Parking Office.

Algonquin College reserves the right to remove any vehicle from the property that is in contravention of these rules and regulations or presenting an environmental hazard. Parking permits will be purchased at the campus regularly attended (the home campus) by that staff or student. All vehicles should be locked. Charges are for use of the Parking Space only.

Algonquin College assumes no responsibility whatsoever for loss or damage to the vehicle by way of theft, collision or otherwise, to the vehicle or its contents, however caused. All vehicles are parked on Algonquin College property entirely at the owner's risk. Parking permits are not transferable. The College is the only legitimate distributor of parking permits.

Fines for violations may vary depending upon the type of infraction. Vehicles in contravention of parking rules and regulations may be ticketed and or towed from the property at the owner's risk and expense. Parking privileges can be revoked by the Parking Office at anytime for violations.

No vehicle shall be parked on Algonquin College property without displaying a valid parking permit. The permit must be properly displayed. Failure to do so will invalidate the permit. Hang tag permits shall hang from the Rear View Mirror or be placed on the Driver's Side Dash with the **FULL PERMIT VISIBLE AT ALL TIMES**, no exceptions.

Pay and Display lot tickets must be date valid and placed on the driver's side dash with the **FULL TICKET VISIBLE**. Failure to do so will result in a Parking Infraction Notice.

Improperly parked vehicles may be moved or towed at the owner's risk and expense.

Violations while on Algonquin College property are constituted as but not limited to:

- Triple Parking where only two (2) rows are permitted.
- Parking in lots that hold a higher colour permit price range than their own (e.g. a Green Permit bearing vehicle parking in a Red Permit lot).
- Parking in restricted areas such as Handicapped Spaces, Loading Zones, No Parking Zones and Fire Routes, without displaying the required permit (s).
- Parking at a parking meter with a parking permit and no time showing on the meter display.
