



Algonquin's International Education Centre is pleased to announce the position of seven international youth interns funded through our partnership with the Canadian International Development Agency's (CIDA) International Youth Internship Program (IYIP).

The IYIP is an employment program for young Canadians between the ages of 19 to 30, offering work experience for Canadian post-secondary graduates overseas. The internships runs for a six month period, including 5 months abroad where interns are provided with valuable international development work experience.

If you are Canadian, between 19-30 years of age, under or unemployed, and will be a graduate from a post-secondary institution, you could be eligible.
