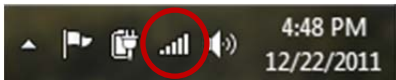


Connecting to the Wireless Network (Windows 7)

- 1) Click on the **wireless icon** on the bottom right of your screen.



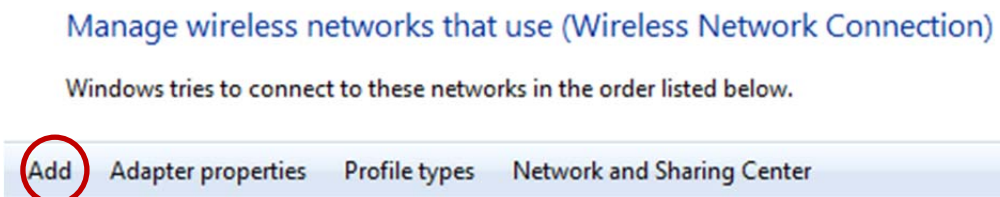
- 2) Open **Network and Sharing Center**.



- 3) Click on the **Manage Wireless Networks**.



- 4) Click on the **Add** button.



Connecting to the Wireless Network (Windows 7)

- 5) Click on **manually create a network profile**.



Manually create a network profile

This creates a new network profile or locates an existing network and saves a profile for the network on your computer. You need to know the network name (SSID) and security key (if applicable).

- 6) Enter in the following information:

Security Key: Hide character

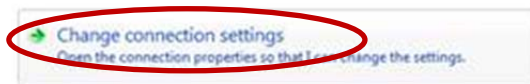

- 7) Click on **Change connection settings**.

- 8) Ensure that the following settings are in place and then select **Settings**:

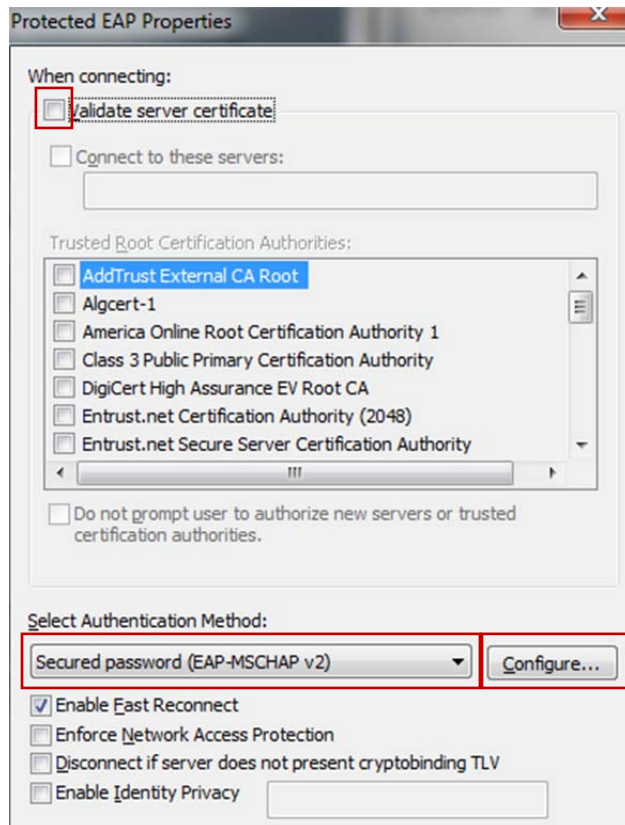

- 9) Uncheck **Validate Server Certificate** and ensure that **EAP-MSCHAP-2** is selected. Then, click on **Configure**.

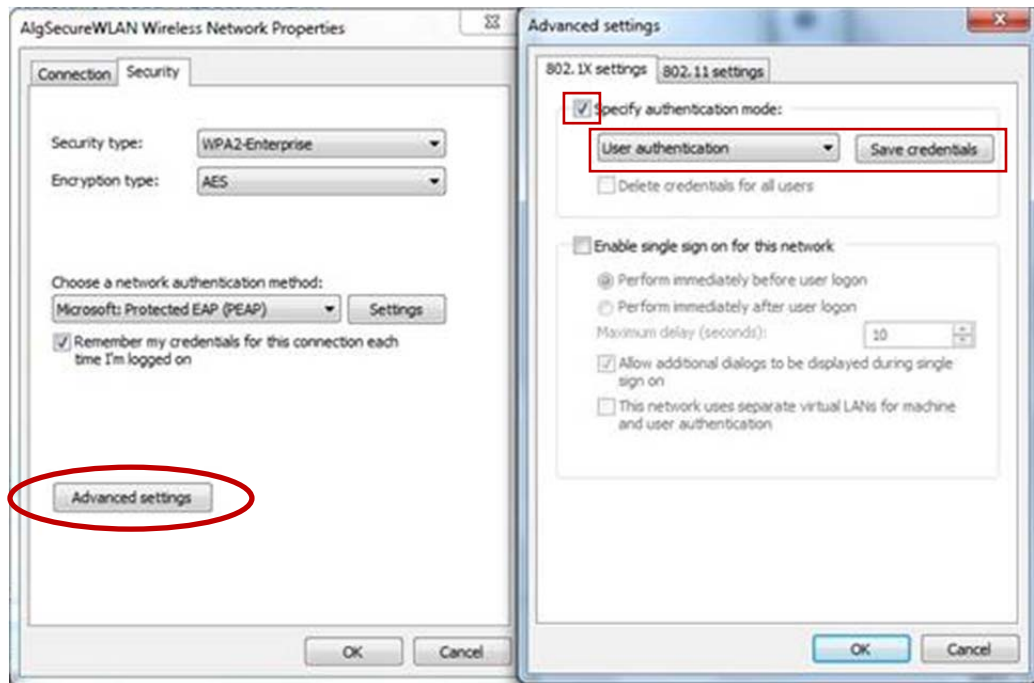


- 10) Uncheck **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)**. Click **OK**.

- 11) Click **Advanced settings**. Then, check **Specify authentication mode**. Select **User authentication**. Click on **Save credentials** Button.



- 12) Type in your **Algonquin Username** and **Password**. Click on **OK** Button in the three open windows.
