

# Learn to use your iPad/Android Tablet Courses

## FAQs

### Do I need to bring my tablet?

Yes, you do. The college doesn't supply tablets as this is a chance for you to learn how to use the tablet you've got at home.

### What should I do to prepare for the course?

Make sure your tablet is fully charged before coming to class. That way you won't have to worry about losing your power. If you want to get a head start, you can sign up for an Apple ID (if you have an iPad) account or a Google account (for an Android tablet). Bring that login information with you. If setting up an account seems overwhelming, fear not - Farren can guide you through the process at the beginning of the class.

### What if I just have a specific question about using the computer?

We have arranged the course so that it's limited to a maximum of 25 participants. That way, participants will have the opportunity to ask the instructor specific questions and receive some one-on-one attention.

### I don't know if my tablet is an iPad or Android. How do I figure it out?

An iPad tablet is an Apple product. Most other tablets are Android based, which means they use the operating system, Android, to function. The only real exceptions are the Microsoft tablet, which runs off Windows, and the Blackberry tablet. Unfortunately, this course can't accommodate Windows or Blackberry tablets.

### What is your refund policy?

Refunds will not be granted once the scheduled class takes place. A full refund minus a \$20 administrative fee will be issued if you register but need to withdraw before the course begins. You will receive a full refund if the College has to cancel the course.
