

Algonquin College adopted a No Smoking Policy in July, 1998. (Directive A5)

This policy prohibits smoking in all College owned or leased facilities, outside main entrances and within 5 metres of all other entrances.

The purpose of the policy is to control exposure to environmental tobacco smoke (ETS) and to restrict smoking to areas that are away from general public areas and entrance ways.

Provincial legislation and municipal by-laws require that smoking be prohibited in public places and the College is required to enforce these regulations.

WHERE CAN YOU SMOKE ?

In an effort to control smoking, smoking shelters have been introduced in various locations around the College Campus. These shelters are intended to keep tobacco smoke from close proximity to the buildings and alleviate congestion at entrance ways.

WHERE ARE SMOKING SHELTERS LOCATED ?

At Woodroffe Campus:

- East side of “C” building
- Courtyard between “J” and the Cafeteria
- East side of “H” building
- South West side of “B” building

At Rideau Campus:

- Cafeteria patio lower level “E” building
- South East corner of “B” building
- South West corner of “B” Building

At Pembroke campus:

- West side of the building



The College is keenly interested in your health and well being. Not smoking is the best possible method to protect your own health and the health of persons around you.

Information on Smoking Cessation Programs is available through the Health Services Department at the College.

ENFORCEMENT

College Security Officers are authorized to enforce the No Smoking Policy by issuing warning notices and fines to persons who contravene the policy.

The fine structure is as follows:

1st violation: Warning Notice

2nd violation: \$20.00 Fine

3rd violation: \$50.00 Fine

Subsequent violations: \$100.00 Fine

Student accounts can be encumbered for failure to pay fines.

The College is requesting the cooperation of all smokers in keeping away from all entrances of all buildings (minimum distance of approximately 5 metres) with the exception of "C" building, Woodroffe Campus where smoking is prohibited anywhere near the front entrance and the stairs leading to the building.

Your assistance in helping to maintain a safe environment for everyone's enjoyment is appreciated.

It should be clearly recognized that Algonquin College does not condone the use of tobacco products. Health Canada and the Surgeon General in the United States have determined that smoking tobacco products is harmful to your health. These shelters are provided solely as a means to control a serious health hazard for building occupants by removing the hazard from close proximity to the building.
