INCIDENT INFORMATION:

During the last several weeks four black, IBM Think Pad Lap Top computers with black nylon cases were stolen from B building lockers on the first and second floors.

Other related incidents included a black Danier Leather jacket was stolen from a locker in H building and two purses from other locations.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

In all cases, small and inexpensive locks were securing these lockers that were easily compromised. At the very least, a Dudley or Master lock, which can be purchased on Campus, should be used to secure lockers.

It is extremely important that locker occupants not leave anything of high value in their locker, namely; lap top computers, expensive jackets, cameras, tools, purses, wallets, or money.

Thieves are usually interested in money or items of value that can be quickly converted to cash.
