**INCIDENT INFORMATION:**

On October 4, 2002, October 8, 2002, October 11, 2002, October 15, 2002, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 10 a.m., fraudulent daily parking passes were circulated on campus for parking lot #12, Woodroffe Campus.

When calling Crime Stoppers, anyone who wishes to remain anonymous may do so, and if the information given leads to an arrest, a cash reward will be issued to the citizen.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Individuals, who utilize College parking facilities, must purchase a valid parking pass from the college. When parking in lot #12, passes must be obtained through the "pay Display Machines".

It is extremely important not to purchase parking passes from any unauthorized individuals. Persons who may approach you in the parking lots attempting to sell passes or persons selling passes for less than the normal value are not authorized by the College.
