

**1 CONSTRUCTION SAFETY MEASURES**

- 1.1 Observe and enforce construction safety measures of National Building Code (NBC), Provincial Government, Workers Compensation Board and municipal authority. In any case of conflict or discrepancy more stringent requirements shall apply.
- 1.2 Abide by all safety measures called for by the Owner. These requirements will be provided by the Project Manager and outlined at the construction startup meeting.

**2 OVERLOADING**

- 2.1 Ensure no part of work is subjected to loading that will endanger its safety or will cause permanent deformation.

**3 FALSEWORK**

- 3.1 Design and construct falsework in accordance with CSA-S269.1.

**4 SCAFFOLDING**

- 4.1 Design and construct scaffolding in accordance with CSA-S269.2.
- 4.2 Construct and maintain scaffolding in rigid, secure and safe manner.
- 4.3 Erect scaffolding independent of walls. Remove promptly when no longer required.

**5 WHMIS**

- 5.1 Comply with requirements of Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) regarding use, handling, storage, and disposal of hazardous materials; and regarding labelling and provision of material safety data sheets acceptable to Labour Canada and Health and Welfare Canada.
- 5.2 Deliver copies of WHMIS data sheets to Owner on delivery of materials.
