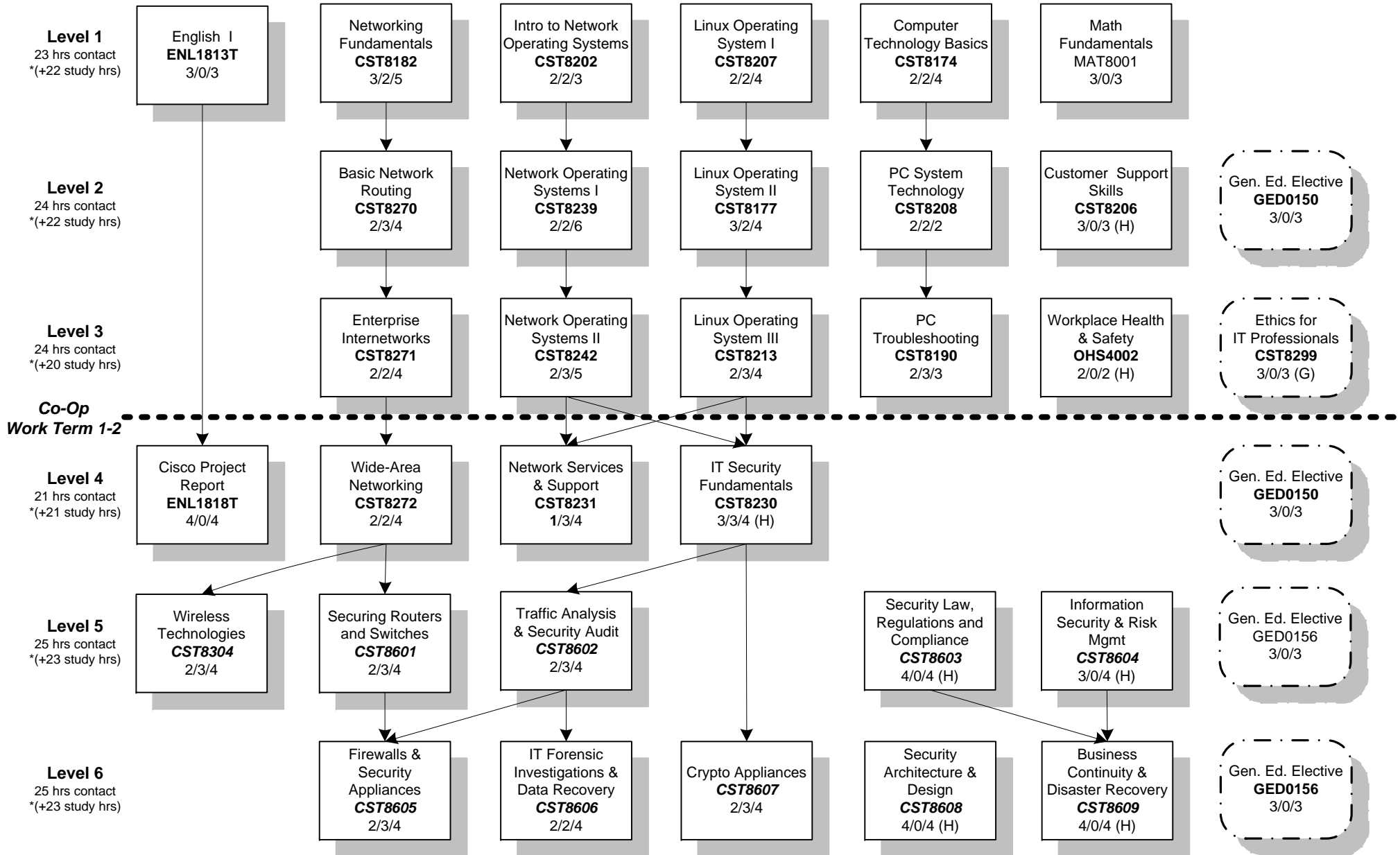

## Co-Op Information

In your level 03, you will be registered in the course **WKT8100E – Co-Op Work Term Preparation**. In this course you are invited to **apply** for Co-Op. Students are eligible to apply if they:

- have a cumulative GPA of 2.70 or better for level 01 and 02 combined and a good academic record
- have full-time status in level 03
- by the end of level 03, will have completed all courses in levels 01, 02 and 03
- have level 04 remaining to be completed upon return from co-op work terms

## Admission Requirements

The 3 year Computer Systems Technology (0155XWO) Advanced Diploma program is designed as a flow-through program from the existing 2-year Computer Systems Technician program.

The admission criteria for the **Computer Systems Technology (0155XWO)** program are:

- Successful completion of Algonquin's Computer Systems Technician (0150XWO) program requirements.
- For direct flow through students, a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher is required.
- Applicants who are not flowing directly from the Computer Systems Technician (0150XWO) program to the Computer Systems Technology program **OR** applicants who have not completed a qualifying version of Algonquin's Computer Systems Technician (0150XWO) program but with similar or equivalent knowledge/experience, will be assessed on an individual basis through an **Advanced Standing** application to the program's level 05.

- **N.B.:** One of the key criteria for Advanced Standing applicants includes successful completion of:
  - o CCNA Rev 3.12 training through Cisco accredited institution; or
  - o CCNA Certification version 640-801 or better

**Please note:** New students who wish to apply to this program must first apply to the Computer Systems Technician (0150XWO) program through OCAS. **During level 04** of the 2-year program, a sign-up process will allow students wishing to pursue the Computer Systems Technology program to apply and be assessed for eligibility to the third year of the program.
