

## Disability Documentation



For the following disabilities, a Medical Report from a Physician / Hospital is required.

- The CSD can give you a blank 'Request for Report' form that your doctor can fill out.
- If documentation already exists at your physician's or at a hospital, the CSD can fill out a Form 14 Release form asking the physician / hospital to send the documents.

- ADD/ADHD
- Brain Injury (neuropsychological assessment)
- Medical Condition (ie: illness, injury, chronic condition)
- Mental Illness / Psychiatric (incl. anxiety disorders, depression)
- Mobility Impairment
- Blind / Low Vision:  
and/or provide documentation from Service Agency,  
ie: CNIB
- Deaf / Hard of Hearing:  
or provide the most recent Audiology report  
(this does not apply to persons requiring  
interpretation services only)

## Disability Documentation-Learning Disabilities

For Learning Disabilities, the following documentation is required:



1. Psychoeducational Assessment
2. Most recent IPRC (Identification, Placement, Review Committee)

- **IPRC:** contact the last school you attended.

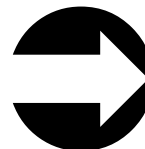
