OYAP provides high school students with the opportunity to begin apprenticeship training while they are still in high school.

Your first step is to get registered and your school board/OYAP Coordinator/Co-op teacher should have provided you with your Training Agreement. Please sign, and have your employer sign, all three copies of your Training Agreement once you have read and agree to the Terms and Conditions of the Training Agreement as noted on the back of the document. If you are under 18 years old you will need to have the document signed where it indicates "Parent or Guardian."

You should have also received your Training Standard for your particular trade that you will need to get signed off, if your employer is in agreement, as you acquire the skills of the trade. Your next step after your agreement is registered with the Ministry is to become a member of the Ontario College of Trades (OCOT). This is free of charge for OYAP students.
