Course Description

Understanding an individual's developmental stage in relation to challenges they may face directs the intervention of social service workers. Students examine various theories of psychosocial development including Freud, Maslow and Erikson in connection to the interrelationship of the biopsychosocial aspects of ages and stages from birth to late adulthood. The goals of studying lifespan development are to describe, explain, and optimize human development throughout a person's entire life. Students study the interaction between different theories; cultural, social, and historical impacts; and biological maturation to gain a holistic understanding of human development. Students also gain a personal understanding of their own lives in the context of psychosocial and lifespan development.
