3. 3.1 2017-2018 Draft Audited Financial Statements
Annual Management Discussion and Analysis Report

D. McNair, Vice President, Finance and Administration presented the 2017-2018 Draft Audited Financial Statements and provided highlights and details of the report. The Draft Audited Financial Statements of Algonquin College are prepared in a format required by the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development that complies with financial reporting standards set by the Public Sector Accounting Board.

Current assets have increased by \$14.3 million. This is primarily due to an increase in accounts receivable, short-term investments, and cash holdings. Long-term assets have increased by \$23.2 million. This is primarily due to increases in the net book value of capital assets, most notably in assets under development. Current liabilities have increased by \$11.9 million, primarily due to an increase in accounts payable, accrued liabilities, and deferred revenue. These cumulative changes to the Statement of Financial Position have resulted in a Current Ratio of 1.44:1 compared to 1.48:1 for the prior year.
