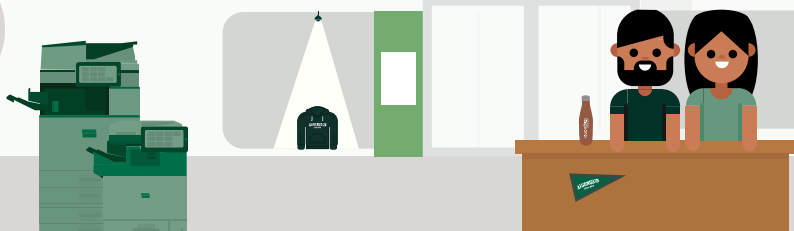


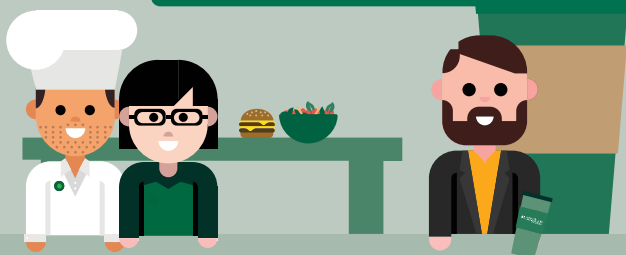

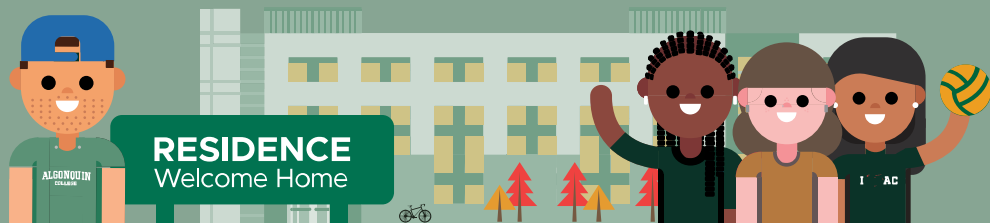

AC CARD + U-PASS

AC CARD + U-PASS: THE ONLY CARD YOU NEED ON CAMPUS

Your AC Card + U-Pass is more than just an ID - it's your key to unlocking a world of convenience and opportunities. Your AC Card + U-Pass can be used to:

- Travel on all OC Transpo and STO routes
- Borrow equipment, rooms & more
- Access labs & rooms
- Identification for exams & more
- Eat on campus using your Meal Plan
- Print on campus
- Shop & pay on campus

AC CASH VS. MEAL PLANS

Your AC Card + U-Pass has two accounts; a Meal Plan account and an AC Cash account. What's the difference? **AC Cash** accounts are used to spend money on campus wherever AC Cash is accepted, including for food. **Meal Plan** accounts are used for food only. Visit page 9 for more details on Meal Plans. AC Cash is pay-as-you-go, Meal Plan must be paid in advance.

FUNDING THE LIFESTYLE: HOW TO ADD AC CASH TO YOUR CARD

Adding funds to your AC Cash account is easy! You, your family members, parents, guardians, or friends can easily contribute to your account by following these simple steps:

1. Visit algonquincollege.com/accard
2. Click on "Go to my account"
3. Select "AC Card Account Login"
4. Choose "Parents" or "Students" in the login box
5. If you chose "Students", enter your Algonquin College username and password. If you chose "Parents", enter the student number & last name
6. Select the "Add Money" Tab

PRO TIPS

- You can also load funds onto your AC Cash account at one of five self-service loading kiosks on campus.
- When logging into your account use your AC username and password.

AC CARD + U-PASS: YOUR TICKET TO UNLIMITED TRANSIT

Your **AC Card** serves as your **U-Pass**. Get ready to experience the convenience and freedom of unlimited travel on both OC Transpo and STO routes. As a full-time student, the cost of your U-Pass is already included in your fees. With your AC Card + U-Pass you can explore the city without worrying about fares: algonquincollege.com/upass

GETTING AN AC CARD + U-PASS

1. Login to ACSIS to obtain your network username and password.
2. Using your network credentials, log in to acphoto.algonquincollege.com to submit your photo online for your AC Card + U-Pass online.
3. Be sure to pay your tuition or defer your fees.
4. **Check your email!** You will receive an email to notify you that your card is ready for pickup.
5. Visit algonquincollege.com/accard to view pickup times and locations!

ONE PASS, MAKE IT LAST!

Make sure to hang on to your AC Card + U-Pass from term to term. For future terms your U-Pass will be automatically renewed if you are eligible and have paid/deferred your fees.



PRO TIPS

- When using your AC Card + U-Pass for transit, remove it from your wallet and place it directly on the fare reader for up to **four seconds**.

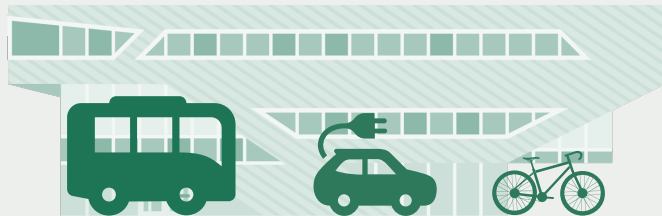
CONVENIENCE UNLOCKED: LOCKER RENTALS MADE EASY

Secure your belongings and lighten your load by renting a locker on campus. To rent a locker, simply visit algonquincollege.com/lockers or visit Parking, Card, and Locker Services located in E120 (Student Commons) during business hours. We make it convenient for you to keep your belongings safe and organized.

TRANSPORTATION: SUSTAINABLE OPTIONS

At Algonquin College, we prioritize sustainable transportation options. Parking Services proudly supports various methods of eco-friendly commuting, including:

- U-Pass program
- Bike racks (700+ bike parking spots on campus)
- Car sharing with Communauto
- Carpool program
- Electric vehicle charging stations
- Self-serve bike repair stations



PRO TIPS

- If you purchase a Lot 8 permit, you can park in Lot 9. If you purchase a Lot 9 permit, you can park in Lot 16, should your lot be full.
- You can Park, Pay & Go using the Honk Mobile app!
- Save with MultiPacks: Purchase MultiPacks using the Honk Mobile app and enjoy a 10% discount on a pack of 10 daily parking passes when pre-paid. MultiPacks have limited availability, so make sure to purchase them early.

1. Contact mealplans@algonquincollege.com to activate your Meal Plan account.
2. Present your AC Card at checkout.
3. Tap your card to pay!

For students living in Residence, our Residence Meal Plans offer the best value for your money, allowing you to save up to 13% every time you enjoy a meal.

A Meal Plan is required for all residents. This plan ensures you have access to delicious meals throughout your stay in Residence.

If you're interested in a residence Meal Plan, but are not living in residence, please contact our office at 613-727-4723 extension 7615 or email to: mealplans@algonquincollege.com. Two-term Meal Plans require a Minimum Usage of \$3,360 by the end of the second term (April 2027).

Listed prices include a non-refundable administration fee of \$150. The administration fee is not added to the account as meal dollars. For example, the Light Meal Plan costs \$3,510, which will provide \$3,360 in meal dollars. A minimum purchase of the "Light" Meal Plan is mandatory for all students in residence.

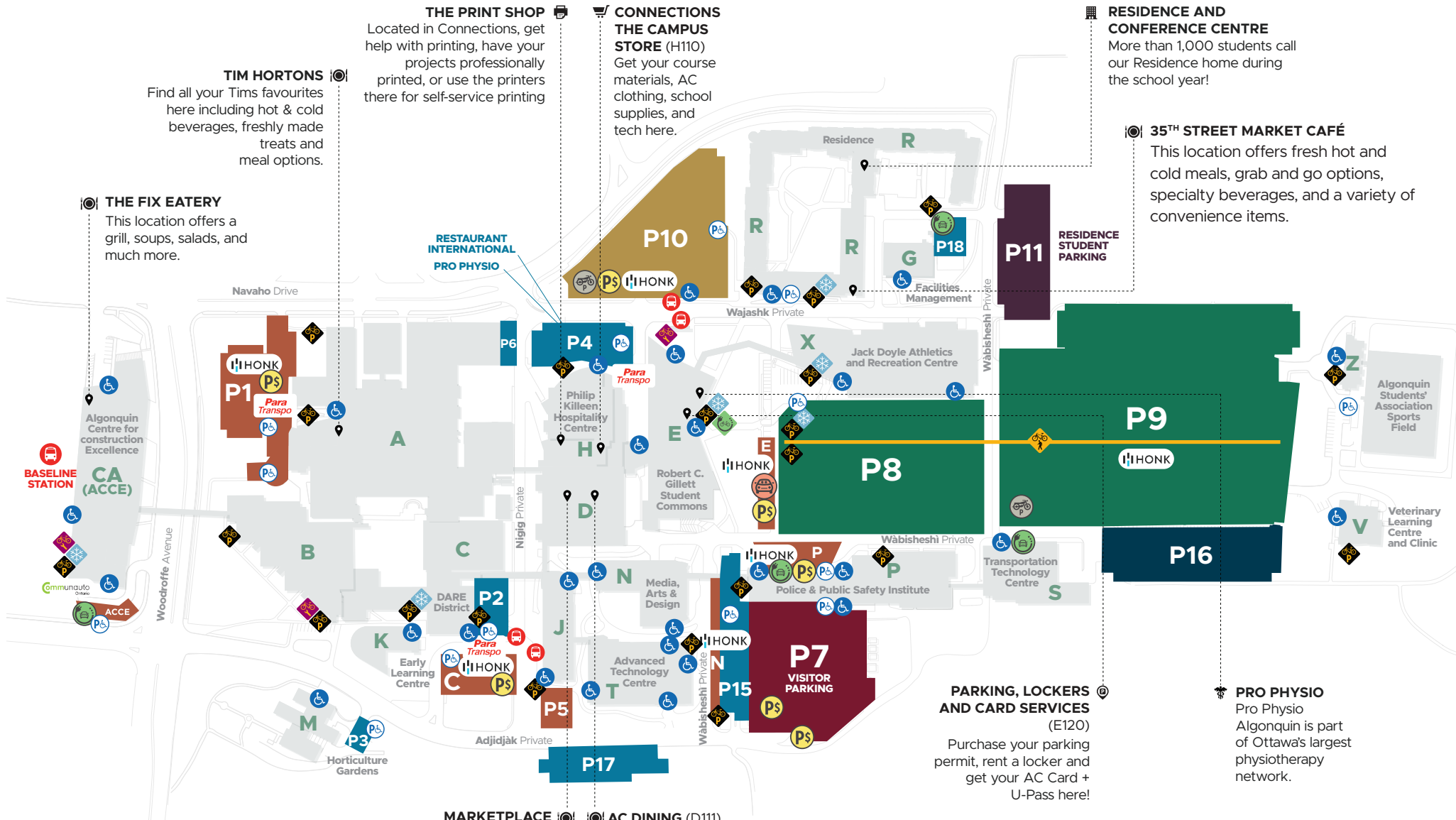

PRINT SERVICES

PRINT IT, COPY IT, SCAN IT: AC PRINTERS ON CAMPUS

The College fleet printers allow you to print, copy and scan at a variety of convenient locations across campus. To easily send your document to an on campus printer:

1. Print from library and lab computers using the AC Print driver.
2. Install and use the AC Print driver on your mobile device.

Once you have sent a document to print, you can choose to print at printers located in labs, in common areas, classrooms and hallways. At these printers, simply tap your AC Card and follow the prompts on the screen to release your print jobs.

PRINT ON THE GO

Print from your phone, tablet, or laptop effortlessly with AC Print. Print your document directly from your device by tapping your AC Card on a campus printer. Before printing, check your available print balance and add AC Cash if needed.

Use your Algonquin College username and password as your login credentials for on-campus printing.

DYK: YOU GET A \$13 PRINT BALANCE EACH SEMESTER?

Full-time students who have paid the full IT Fee receive a \$13 Print Balance at the start of each term (one hundred 8.5 x 11 printed black and white pages). Print balances are non-refundable and do not roll over into future terms. Don't have a print balance? You can still print by adding funds to your AC Card.

- Ottawa campus has 150+ printers across campus!
