Call for submissions

The Rosser Boardroom and Art Gallery, is inviting all Algonquin College employees to submit works of art to this unique space. The Rosser Boardroom and Art Gallery, located on the 5th floor of C Building at the Ottawa Campus of Algonquin College, is primarily looking for submissions of paintings (variety of mediums) and photography but will be accepting three-dimensional artwork as well. Submissions will be on display for approximately one year.

Please note: All submissions, with the exception of three-dimensional artwork **must be framed.**

The Gallery's mission is to create a space that facilitates the Algonquin College community's involvement in art by showcasing the many artistic talents of College employees. Artists do not need any previous experience in showing their work.

Entry Information and Guidelines for Submission

Important Dates

- All artists must submit the **application form** by noon on Friday, May 19, 2017. Artists will be advised of acceptance the within 1-2 weeks.
- Accepted artwork must be dropped off at the office of Victoria Guitard at <u>guitarv@algonquincollege.com</u> in C521 before Friday, June 23, 2017.
- A viewing will be scheduled in Fall 2017 stay tuned!

Guidelines

- All Staff and Faculty are permitted to submit a maximum of three images of recent work.
- Digital images that are submitted must be saved as a JPEG. All submissions are to be emailed to Victoria Guitard at
 guitarv@algonquincollege.com. Images must have a minimum resolution of 72dpi and a file size of at least 1 MB to
 maximum 3 MB per image. Please ensure that you label each image with an image number, name and title prior to
 submitting your art work.
 - **Example:** 01.lastname.firstname.title.jpg, 02.lastname.firstname.title.jpg, 03.lastname.firstname.title.jpg
- All paintings must be framed and have a wire hanging system on the back.
- All paintings must be less than 22 x 26 inches as the gallery does not have room to accommodate larger pieces.
- There is limited space for 3D artwork but it is being accepted.
- Contact information will be available for inquiries regarding artwork, artist and price of artwork if a Gallery patron is interested in purchasing on display. Prices will not be displayed.

Please complete an application form and include an artist biography and a brief statement explaining your inspiration behind the artwork you are submitting.
