

## What Roles are Involved in Mapping Revision Process?

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There are three major roles involved in the process of revising, approving, and completing maps. They include:

**Department Map Creator:**

Department users such as Program Coordinators are assigned the permissions to create, revise, and submit a map for review.

**Map Reviewer:**

Curriculum Consultants are assigned the permissions to create, edit, review, endorse (reviewed status), return the status back to Draft map, and complete which activates the map in the production version.

**Map Admin:**

Academic Development specialists are assigned permissions to perform all tasks to assist the Department Map Creator and Map Reviewer roles, if the need arises. The map status transitions as the map is created, revised, submitted, reviewed, approved, and completed.
