AC	Algonquin College
ACR	<b>Annual Curriculum Review</b> is a lifecycle process that manages, approves, and applies changes to College program curriculum and narrative on a yearly basis.
ACR-COMMS Roles	<p><b>ACR-COMMS ROLES</b></p> <p>There are three major roles:</p> <p><b>Department Map Creator:</b> Department users (such as Program Coordinators) are assigned the permissions to create, revise, and submit a map for review.</p> <p><b>Map Reviewer:</b> Curriculum Consultants are assigned the permissions to create, edit, review, endorse (reviewed status), return the status back to Draft map, and complete which activates the map in the production version.</p> <p><b>Map Admin:</b> Academic Development specialists are assigned permissions to perform all tasks to assist the Department Map Creator and Map Reviewer roles if the need arises.</p>
AODA	Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act
Business Process Flow or process map	A pictorial (or series of pictorial) representation of the steps involved a business process. It is a method to assist in improving a business process. When creating the map or flow, the business process dimensions should be assessed, i.e., business owners, roles, responsibilities, best practices, inputs, and outputs.

COMMS	Course Outline Mapping and Management System is a College in-house developed course outline content system. The PLO and EES maps are revised and activated in the COMMS3 environment using automated functionality.

Program Standard	Program standard is a document produced by the Ministry of Colleges and Universities that sets out the essential learning that a student must achieve before being deemed ready to graduate. A program standard applies to all programs of instruction in an identified category regardless of the funding source and, for most programs, consists of a vocational standard, a generic skills standard, and general education requirements. Prior to graduation, students must achieve all three parts of the program standard.
