

Provisional Certificate Content Requirements

As per ICAS guidelines, in order to recognize and accept a provisional certificate in lieu of an official graduation diploma, the Provisional Certificate must contain:

1. Full name of student
2. Name of the Program
3. Duration of the Program
4. Date when final examination was completed
5. Name and Class of the degree
6. Date degree was awarded
7. Signature and stamp of correct authority. This should be from the Registrar's Office or similar issuing authority in the sending institution and not a faculty member for example

Provisional Certificates without all of the above information cannot be accepted as proof of graduation.
