

Provisional Certificate Content Requirements

As per ICAS guidelines, in order to recognize and accept a provisional certificate in lieu of an official graduation diploma, the Provisional Certificate must contain:

- 1. Full name of student
- 2. Name of the Program
- 3. Duration of the Program
- 4. Date when final examination was completed
- 5. Name and Class of the degree
- 6. Date degree was awarded
- 7. Signature and stamp of correct authority. This should be from the Registrar's Office or similar issuing authority in the sending institution and not a faculty member for example

Provisional Certificates without all of the above information cannot be accepted as proof of graduation.
