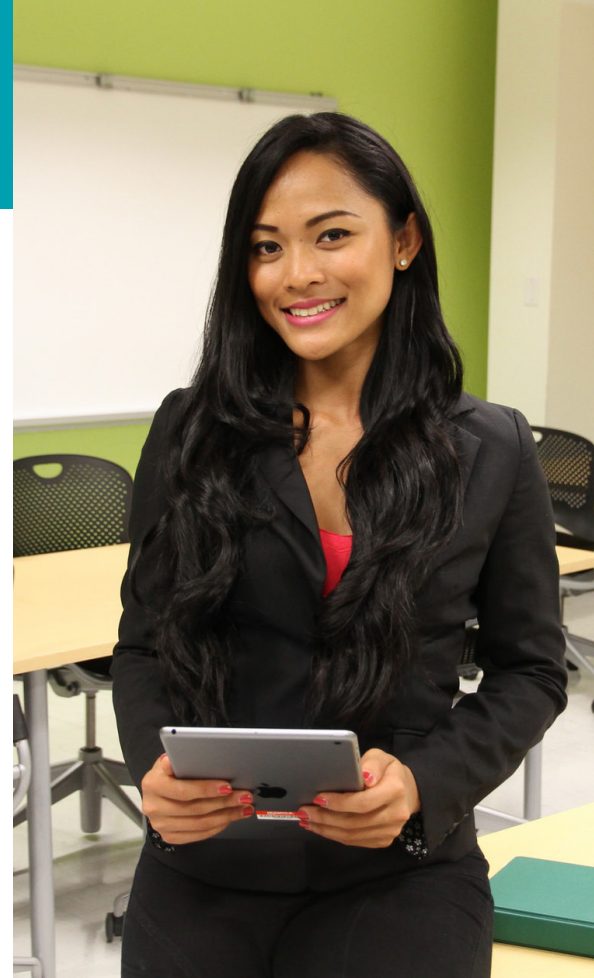
Participants in this program will:

They will introduce your faculty and staff to current ESL/EFL teaching methodologies and theories of second language acquisition practiced in the English-speaking world, specifically in the areas of teaching and integrating the four language skills (Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing), pedagogical grammar, and language assessment.

Upon successful completion of the program, participants will receive the Certificate of Achievement in TEF/SL issued by Algonquin College Language Institute.



PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Your teachers will participate in a four-week training session that will incorporate lectures, workshops, seminars, video demonstrations, observation and teaching practica, self-study sessions, and cultural activities.

Duration: 4 weeks

Morning: TEF/SL Modules - 8:00 -11:00, Monday to Friday

Lunch break: 11:00 - 12:00

Afternoon: ESL Classes - 12:00 - 16:00, Monday to Friday
2 skills maximum

Self-study: 5-10 hours/week

Weekends: Optional cultural activities may be included (*trips to Toronto, Montreal, Quebec, Niagara Falls, museums, parks*).

Additional costs are involved for in-town/out-of-town/overnight trips.
