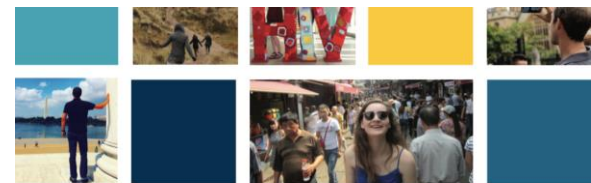

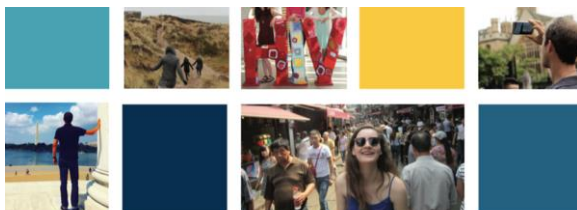

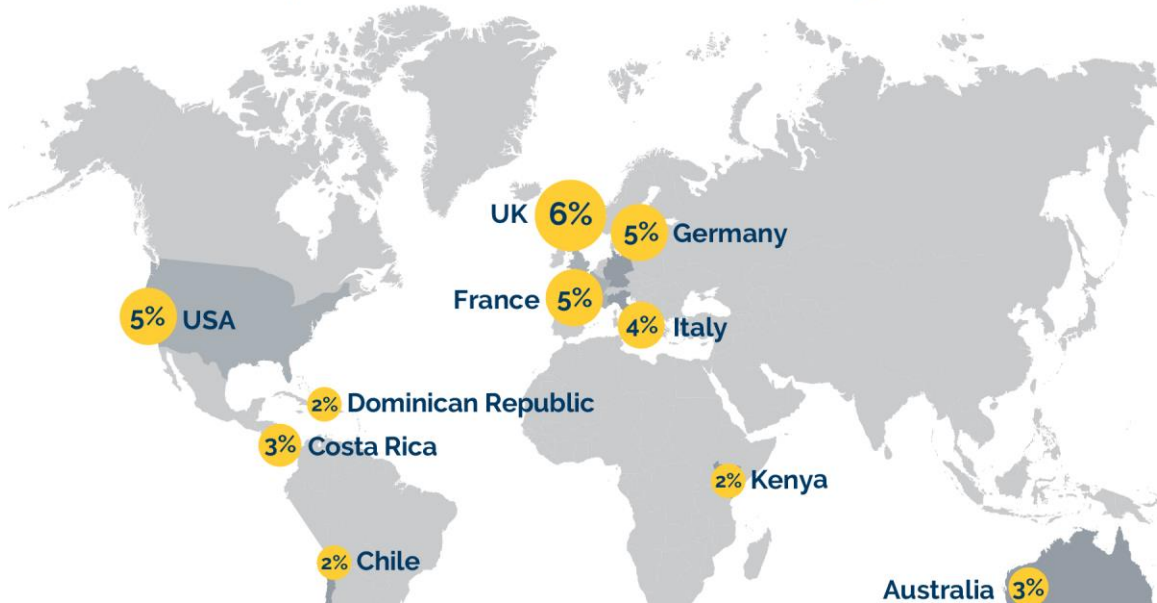

Top Five Fields of Study of Outbound College Students²

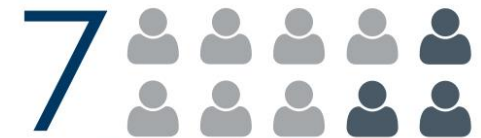
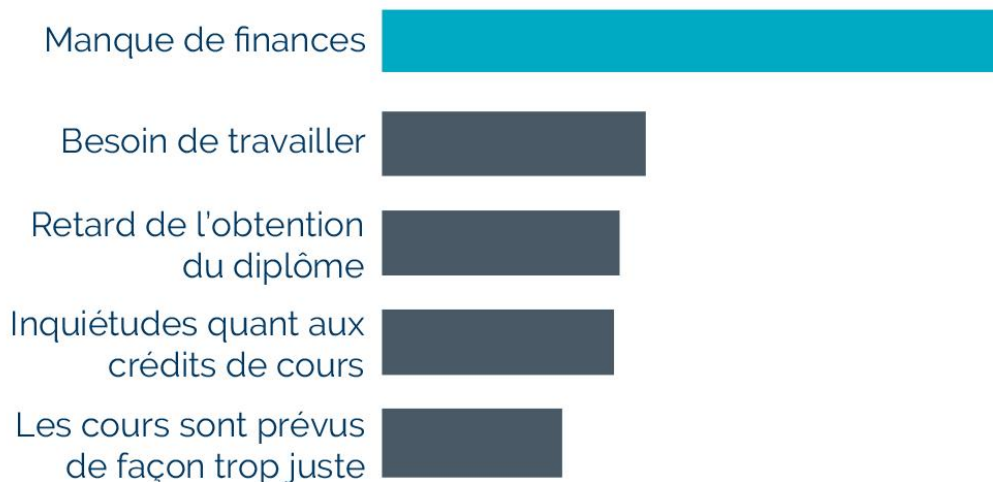

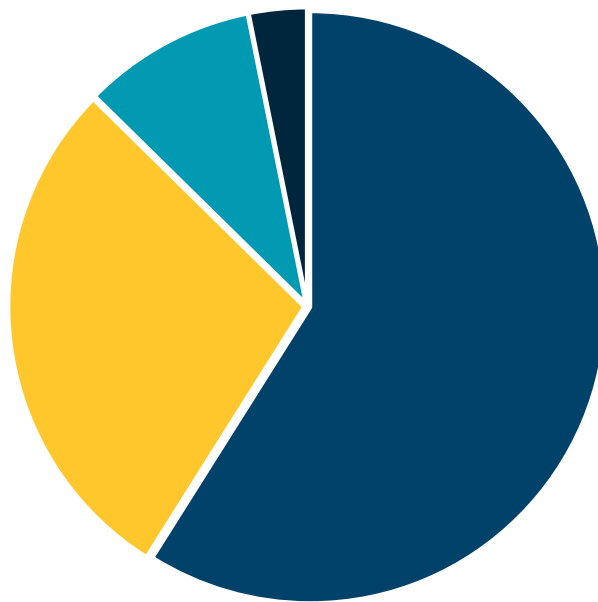
