CHECKLIST FOR NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Arriving to Canada	
Plan for your accommodations with these helpful resources .	
If using our free Arrival Services, book as soon as your travel dates are known.	
Health insurance is mandatory and provided to all full-time international students. If you are arriving early, you can purchase early arrival health insurance through guard.me.	
Review and print important documents to carry and present at the border if requested.	
Immigration Reminders	
Review the conditions and expiry dates of your immigration documents,	
e.g. Study Permit, Temporary Resident Visa.	
Create copies of important immigration documents including your passport and study permit.	
If your Letter of Acceptance (LOA) indicates you have a work requirement, ensure you have a co-op/internship work permit (if applicable).	

If you require a **co-op/internship work permit**, **apply for it is soon as possible**.

Preparing for a Successful Start

MANDATORY - Find out **which orientation** you are required to attend and **register**.

MANDATORY - Complete the **'Succeed in Canada' course on Brightspace** once you have been granted 'registered' status on ACSIS.

Complete the '**AC Café' course on Brightspace** to learn the ins and outs of AC life.

MANDATORY - **Download the iCent app**, the free app designed for international students to access resources and services and receive notifications. Get in the habit of checking it regularly.
