#### **CHECKLIST FOR NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

Arriving to Canada	
Plan your housing and accommodations with these helpful resources	
If using our free Arrival Services, book as soon as your travel dates are known	
<b>Health insurance</b> is mandatory and provided to all full-time international students. If you are arriving early, you can <b>purchase early arrival health insurance</b> through Guard.me	
<b>Review and print important documents</b> to carry and present at the border if requested	
Connect with future classmates, current students, and our International Student Ambassadors through the <b>Goin' App</b>	
Immigration Reminders	
Review the conditions, remarks and expiry dates written on all your immigration documents. Create digital copies of all your permits, including your passport	
Be aware of the <b>terms and conditions</b> all study permit holders must follow	
Your Letter of Acceptance indicates if you need a co-op/internship work permit. If you need one but don't have it, <b>learn how to apply right away</b>	
Bookmark the <b>IEC Immigration Resources</b> for key information related to employment, immigration applications, and more	
Preparing for a Successful Start	
MANDATORY - Find out which orientation you are required to register and attend	
<b>MANDATORY</b> - Complete the self-paced 'AC Cafe' course on Brightspace to learn the ins and outs of AC Life. <b>You must complete the International Student module</b>	
MANDATORY - Download the iCent app, a free app designed for AC international students to access resources, services and receive notifications. Get in the habit of checking it regularly for updates
