Module #2 Assignment: Group Research Report

Work in groups to identify, research, and report on a select topic of interest related to the information presented in Lectures 4, 5, and/or 6.

Purpose

Undertake independent group research that connects course materials to local, national, and/or international issues related to the topic of globalization and food.

Relevant Course Learning Requirements

- Debate with fluency topical issues of global interest associated with global citizenship (CLR 1)
- Assess with familiarity and across difference the relationship between global struggles and the project of global citizenship (CLR 2)
- Develop a collection of foundational resources that can inform decision-making related to social justice (CLR 3)
- Adopt a more inclusive approach to global issues (CLR 5)

Instructions

- 1. Form groups of at least 3 members.
- 2. **Choose** a topic related to globalization and food that interests all group members and about which you would like to learn more.
- 3. **Develop and submit a written report** that is a maximum of four double-spaced pages (excluding list of References) in which your group demonstrates your course learning by doing the following:
 - a. <u>**Discuss</u>** your chosen topic (see # 2 above) in relation to ONE concept introduced in Lesson 4, 5, or 6 that you define using at one required learning resource *embedded* in one of these lessons;</u>
 - b. Do some internet research to learn more about the activities of ONE organization and <u>establish</u> a link between this organization's work and the local, national, and global significance of your chosen topic;
 - c. Find AT LEAST ONE peer-reviewed academic journal article through Algonquin's library database or Google Scholar and <u>explain</u> how these academic findings help you to relate your chosen topic to the central course concept: global citizenship, which you clearly define with reference to at least one required learning resource embedded in a module lesson.
