Eligibility

The award is open to all current employees (full-time and part-time, permanent and contract). Individuals may be nominated more than once, but may not receive the award more than once in a twoyear period.

Who can and cannot be nominators?

Employees are encouraged to nominate their peers from across the college community. Selfnominations and nominations put forth by managers for direct reports are not permitted.

Who approves the award nomination?

The Dean's Management Committee, in consultation with others as needed.

How many winners will there be?

There is no pre-determined number of awards to be distributed each year.

Award presentations

Awards will be presented by the Dean at all-employee meetings throughout the year. The award will consist of a certificate of recognition and a special "I Make Algonquin Proud" mug.
