Purpose of the Competition:

The purpose of this competition is for the competitors to demonstrate their Desktop Publishing and communication skills through the creation of a poster to promote Options 2024. Students will be provided with Options logos and a theme in order to produce.

General Skills and Knowledge to be tested:

• Students will be judged on overall visual appeal, use of colour and space and creative use of theme and logos

** No Communication with teacher advisors or visiting students during the competition. All questions are to be directed to the Desktop Publishing leads. This contest is limited to 12 individual competitors.

Equipment and Materials:

Supplied by Competitor:

- Laptop computer with a commonly used publishing program such as:
 Microsoft Publisher, Adobe Photoshop, Adobe In-design, or any other Desktop publishing software
- Their own digital camera
- Have a means of uploading pictures to laptop, ex. Charging cable, email, etc.(Wifi may be limited)
- USB recommended as backup

Supplied by the Committee:

- Option logos in jpeg format(@2) on USB
- OYAP logo on USB
- Screen & Projector
- ** Snacks, lunch and water, supplied for all competitors.

Poster Requirements:

- Size of the poster (11 x 17 inches or 279 x 432mm)
- Resolution: 300 dpi or higher
- Include OYAP & Options logos (provided by the committee)
- Must include "Options 2024"in poster (provided by the committee)
- List of the competition divisions
- Include Theme: Celebrating Diversity in the Trades
- Keep any images or text, 5 mm away from the outside border. Check for any spelling or grammar mistakes
- When saving your design.
 - 1. Save the original format (ex. *.psd) with your layers intact
 - 2. Save As a JPEG image (no layers)
 - 3. Include your first initial plus your last name as part of the file name (original source and the JPEG file)
