

# RENFREW COUNTY SKILLS COMPETITION Scope of Team Carpentry (Teams of 3)

#### **Purpose of the Competition:**

To test the skill, knowledge and attention to detail of a group of students to work as a team in carpentry, and to prepare each student for the demands of industry.

Each school can send a maximum of two (2) teams of 3 students.

#### Skills and Knowledge to be tested:

- To demonstrate skills and knowledge of reading drawings, safe operation of portable power and hand tools, and carpentry techniques.
- To work in a safe, competent and neat manner
- Build a quality project prepared and ready for finishing
- All phases of measurement will deal exclusively in imperial measure

#### NOTE:

- The competitors will be located outside, thus appropriate clothing should be worn.
- The competitors will be constructing an outdoor furniture project. Drawings will be shared with schools ahead of the competition.
- No communication with teacher advisors or visiting students during the competition. All
  questions to be directed to the judges.
- All tools should be in good condition

#### **Equipment and Materials: Supplied by Competitor** Chop Saw/Mitre Saw (max. cut 2'x6') and Twist Drill Bits (up to 3/8") Portable Router with ¼" round-over Stand Handsaw (preferably Japanese style) router bit Chisel(s)/Mallet • Sanding block & paper 80, 100, 120 Cordless jigsaw and blades Framing square/carpenter's square Saw Horse Set sliding T-bevel (aka false square) Impact Driver, Portable Drill, Batteries & PPE (Personal Protective Equipment): CSA approved boots, Charger Hammer, Tape Measure, & Pencil safety glasses Robertson #2 screwdriver and #2 bit • Extension cord with multi-adapter • Quickgrip clamps and chisel/mallet are optional
