Accessing Help from Student Services

Within the student services team is a group of caring staff who support our students in their academic courses as well as their day-to-day life. Almost all of our staff are trained in mental health first aid and as we enter the darker days of November, they will be paying particular attention to how students are feeling on campus.

Our team includes a counsellor, a counsellor for students with disabilities, a learning strategist, an assistive technologist, a health nurse, an Indigenous Elder and a Kampus Kokum and student success specialists. All of these staff are additionally supported by team members that work in our library, financial aid, admissions, housing, co-op and tutoring/coaching services.
