

RENFREW COUNTY SKILLS COMPETITION Scope of Team Carpentry (Teams of 4)

Purpose of the Competition:

To test the skill, knowledge and attention to detail of a group of students to work as a team in carpentry, and to prepare each student for the demands of industry.

Each school can send a maximum of one (1) team of 4 students. Max of 12 teams total.

Skills and Knowledge to be tested:

- To demonstrate skills and knowledge of reading drawings, safe operation of portable power and hand tools, and carpentry techniques.
- To work in a safe, competent and neat manner
- Build a quality project prepared and ready for finishing
- All phases of measurement will deal exclusively in imperial measure

NOTE:

- The competitors will be located outside, thus appropriate clothing should be worn.
- The competitors will be constructing a wood shed project. This is a combination of traditional and post and beam construction. Project plans are here and an exemplar will be provided.
- No communication with teacher advisors or visiting students during the competition. All questions to be directed to the judges.
- All tools should be in good condition

Equipment and Materials: Supplied by Competitor

- Chop Saw/Mitre Saw (max. cut 2'x6') and Stand
- Handsaw
- Chisel(s)/Mallet
- Cordless jigsaw and blades
- Saw Horse Set
- Impact Driver, Portable Drill, Batteries & Charger
- Hammer, Tape Measure, & Pencil
- Robertson #2 screwdriver and #2 bit
- 8'/6' ladder
- ¼" drive for roofing screws

- Twist Drill Bits (up to 3/8")
- Portable Router with 1/2" chamfer router bit
- Sanding block & paper 80, 100, 120
- Framing square/carpenter's square
- sliding T-bevel (aka false square)
- PPE (Personal Protective Equipment): CSA approved boots, safety glasses, hard hat.
- Extension cord with multi-adapter end
- Quick Grip clamps are optional

Equipment and Materials: Supplied by Committee Materials for project (all lumber, steel roofing) Screws / Fasteners (2½", 3" deck screws, roofing screws, structural screws, nails) template for rafters adhesive/glue plans/drawings Exemplar (aka demo shed project) Lunch and water supplied for all competitors
