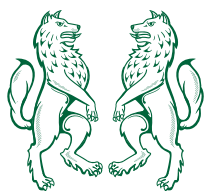

ALGONQUIN COLLEGE'S PROUD HERITAGE

Algonquin College is situated on the traditional, unceded, unsundered territory of the Algonquin Nation. The Anishinàbe Algonquin people are the original inhabitants of the Ottawa River watershed and its tributaries on which Algonquin College's campuses in Ottawa, Pembroke and Perth now sit. To honour and recognize the Algonquin People, the college adopted the name Algonquin when it was founded in 1967.

In Algonquin culture, it is appropriate for guests to acknowledge the hospitality of their hosts when entering their territory. With this tradition in mind, Algonquin College respectfully thanks the Anishinàbe Algonquin People for hosting us on their ancestral lands; both today during this ceremony and each day on our campuses in Ottawa, Perth, and Pembroke. Mìgwech (thank you).

Algonquin College is proud of its strong partnership with the First Nation, Métis, or Inuit communities and organizations with whom we share the common goal of supporting Indigenous learners as they strive for academic and career success. This partnership is realized in many ways, one of which is through Algonquin College's Indigenous Education Council (IEC). This council brings members of First Nations, Métis and Inuit communities and organizations together with Algonquin College leaders and students to identify the unique needs of our Indigenous learners and to work together to meet those needs.

Algonquin College maintains a strong commitment to the over 1,100 learners of First Nation, Métis, and Inuit heritage who attend our institute each year. Algonquin College offers high-quality programs and services reflective of Indigenous cultures and values; such as the Mamidosewin Indigenous Student Centre, the Pathways to Indigenous Empowerment Program and the Indigenous Studies Program. Honorary Degree Recipient **Jason Blaine**

Canadian Country Music Artist, Algonquin College Alumni

Jason Blaine: A Country Star with a Hometown Heart

From Pembroke to Nashville: A Legacy of Giving Back

Country music icon and Pembroke native Jason Blaine has deep community relationships. Though he lives in Nashville, Tennessee, and travels extensively for his successful music career; his heart, his family and some of his best memories are deeply connected to his hometown and to his time at Algonquin College.

Blaine has built a successful career in country music garnering widespread recognition. He has earned 13 nominations from the Canadian Country Music Association, including a win for 2012 Single of the Year. He has also received multiple awards from the Country Music Association of Ontario and the Society of Composers, Authors and Music Publishers of Canada.

His annual Jason Blaine Celebrity Charity Golf Classic contributed \$100,000 to the development of Pembroke's Waterfront Campus building and he donated an additional \$100,000 to create an endowment to establish a financial aid bursary for students in need. In the past 10 years, he's raised over a million dollars for local organizations and charities.

Blaine graduated from Algonquin College's Pembroke Campus with a business degree in 2000. He credits the institution for providing him with the critical and analytical skills required to run a thriving business and to become a successful musician and entrepreneur.

While he fondly remembers his time as a student, he does lament graduating when he did. "My only regret is that I didn't get to attend the brand-new state-of-the-art beautiful campus on the waterfront. That was after my time," he said. "This new campus in Pembroke has served to attract students to stay in Pembroke, who graduate high school and stay local. It's a lot more appealing to want to stay and go to school at a beautiful campus."

He sees the connection between the College and the town as integral and said the College has done a great job creating an attractive campus where students can study and obtain the skills they need and establish roots to set up a family and a business, all in the Ottawa Valley area. For a town formerly dependent on sawmills and manufacturing to now offer future careers in nursing and forestry, that is making a difference in people's futures.

When asked what advice he has for graduates, Blaine said there is no substitute for hard work and perseverance. He urged graduates to have a plan, ask questions and work hard.

"A friend of mine has a great saying, the harder you work, the luckier you get."
