REQUIRED EQUIPMENT LIST:

1. CSA approved footwear. Steel toed, Kevlar, shoes, work boots, Blundstones, etc. as long as they have the green CSA triangle on them.
2. A Type 2(II) hard hat. Any colour is fine, but it *must* be Type 2.
3. A reflective high-vis vest, t-shirt, jacket, etc. The orange and yellow t-shirts or long sleeve shirts, mesh vest, are all acceptable including a full surveyor or tree marking vest with a lot of pockets. Your choice!
4. A whistle. Fox 40 is a great choice...but choose whatever type you wish.
5. Water bottle (no glass)
6. Field clipboard (one that opens and you can store field sheets and pens, etc. inside)
7. Rain gear (we work outside, even if it is raining!)

RECOMMENDED (will help), BUT NOT REQUIRED:

- Pencils (they work even when wet, whereas pens and markers do not)
- Rubber boots
- Field backpack
- Lighter
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray/bug jacket
- Field Knife (if you wish)
- Chest waders – these are not mandatory, and if you can't afford them, this is not a problem. Students do work in the water for several courses, and some students prefer to have their own. We do have a few pairs in the program, but no guarantees of having the right boot size, etc. You *can* get through the course without them, so hold off if you are not sure.
