

Suggested Standard Wording for College and Program Admission Requirements

The following information is provided as a guideline and terms of reference for the development of admissions requirements for new programs. For brevity, it includes examples of the most frequently used subject specific and specialty admission assessment requirements; where other requirements are being suggested, please consult the Registrar's Office. Guidelines and links are also included to explain some MCU binding admission policies and highlight recommendations that will assist in equitable assessment of admission requirements to all applicants.

Important Notes for Developing Eligibility:

As per the <u>Algonquin College Admissions Policy AA04</u>, applicant selection criteria shall be objective, measurable and relevant to the program. Subjective assessments are not acceptable; admissions criteria requiring subject-matter expert review (e.g.: portfolio) must have pre-established criteria evaluating specific technical skills. Interviews or mandatory college visits may not be used as assessment tools.

As per the Admissions Criteria Minister's Binding Policy Directive, no secondary school university preparation course (U-level courses) or Ontario Academic Course (OAC) shall be required as a program eligibility criterion with two exceptions:

1. Collaborative college-university degree programs governed by joint agreements are not subject to the restrictions on use of secondary school university preparation or Ontario Academic Courses, where those requirements are specifically stated in the agreement.

2. The College bachelor's degrees are not subject to the restrictions on use of secondary school university preparation or Ontario Academic Courses.

If work experience or volunteer hours are required, please be specific on the format of submission of proof of attainment. Rationale for the inclusion of this experience requirement is expected.

Police Records Check Documentation/Requirements should not be included as Admission Requirements, these are placement requirements. This information should be listed in Additional Information.

Clinical Placement Eligibility should not be included as Admission Requirements, these are placement requirements. This information should be listed in Additional Information.

If an applicant does not have the subject specific requirements, the Test Centre can test for Grade 12 College level English and Math competency and Grade 11 Math (MBF3C) competency. It cannot provide a test to assess for U level courses or any science courses.

Programs with an expected high demand: Should the number of qualified applicants exceed the number of available places, applicants will be selected on the basis of their proficiency in the required subject specific course(s) [for example, English and Mathematics, etc] or on the basis of their supplemental requirement [for example, HPAT score].

Programs with mandatory portfolios or eligibility packages must work with the Registrar's Office to ensure the supplemental requirements have been formalized before the application cycle is open to applications. Detailed rubrics must be submitted.
