A graduating student may apply for a Cross College Award(s), or may be nominated by a fellow student, faculty member, or others in the College community.

A certificate and monetary prize are awarded to the best all-round graduate in a degree, diploma, or certificate program, attending Algonquin College on a student visa. Selection is based on academic achievement and active participation in extracurricular activities within the College community.

Award Criteria and Requirements

STUDENT VISA

• Graduate attended program on a student visa

HIGH STANDARD OF ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

• 3.60 (or above) cumulative GPA

PARTICIPATION

- Helping on project/activity/program organized by others
- Member of club(s), program council, etc.
- Public relations promotion or program or event
- College Athletics





Cross College Awards The president rosser prize

A graduating student may apply for a Cross College Award(s), or may be nominated by a fellow student, faculty member, or others in the College community.

A certificate and monetary prize are awarded to a graduate in a degree, diploma, or certificate program whose performance within the College community has been outstanding in terms of leadership and participation in student activities and who has maintained a good standard of scholastic achievement in their studies.

Award Criteria and Requirements

- Class representative
- Peer tutoring, formal or informal
- Student (liaison) representative on professional Association
- Students' Association position
- Peer helper or counsellor
- Program Council representative or Chair
- College Athletics
- Organizing a class activity (e.g. graduation event)
- Fund raising
- Managing student (non-academic) project
- Community involvement

Cross College Awards The Robert C. Gillett Leadership Award

A graduating student may apply for a Cross College Award(s), or may be nominated by a fellow student, faculty member, or others in the College community.

A certificate and monetary prize are awarded to a graduate in a degree, diploma or certificate program from the Ottawa, Pembroke, Perth and Online campuses to recognize graduates who demonstrated exemplary volunteer leadership which contributed to the overall Algonquin College Student experience.

Award Criteria and Requirements

- One recipient per eligible campus; if in a particular year recipients are not chosen for each eligible campus the non-disbursed amount will remain to be disbursed equitably at a later date;
- Recipients must be a graduate of a post-secondary or graduate certificate program;
- Recipients to be in good standing with the College;
- Recipients must exemplify, at a minimum, leadership which contributes to the amelioration of the overall Algonquin Student Experience;
- Students must exemplify Algonquin College's core values of caring, integrity, learning and respect;
- Student is graduating in good academic standing.



Cross College Awards The steve stafford memorial continuing Education Award

A graduating student may apply for a Cross College Award(s), or may be nominated by a fellow student, faculty member, or others in the College community.

A certificate and monetary prize are awarded to a graduate in a degree, diploma, or certificate program who demonstrated unusual or extra effort while having completed their program as a part-time student, or having completed the majority of their credential as a part-time student.

Award Criteria and Requirements

- Successfully completed a certificate, diploma, or degree program parttime, or having completed the majority of the credential as a part-time student.
- Demonstration of unusual or extra effort in pursuing program completion.
- In case of a tie, the length of the credential is to be considered.
