

Film and Media Production 1421X04FWO 2023-2024 Academic Cycle Supplemental Form and Recording

All applicants to the Film and Media Production program must submit the following two components:

- 1. Recording: Plan, shoot and edit a one-minute movie with approx. 10-25 shots about any object (such as water bottle, rock, but NOT a person). You should not show a person, with the exception of extreme close ups (ie: a hand holding an object).
 - **Audio:** No dialogue. You may add music for effect (copyrighted music is allowed). NOTE: Your film may be assessed by the college with audio disabled.
 - o The final film should be minimum 30 seconds and maximum 1 minutes in length.
 - Criteria for success:
 - Shots that are dynamic and enhance the story.
 - No vertical video. It must be filmed and delivered in a horizontal aspect ratio.
 - o Sequential story telling. Something happens! It has a start, middle and end.
 - Editing has proper flow and engages the viewer. Fade up and fade down are allowed but no dissolves. No text on screen, no credits and no graphics. Your story must stand on its own merit without the help of graphics.
 - The final film should be uploaded to a platform such as YouTube or Google Drive and a link provided.
 - **Note about equipment:** You may use any camera of your choice (i.e. Gopro, smartphone, DSLR) and basic editing software. <u>Technical ability is not being assessed; only visual storytelling.</u>
