

APPRENTICESHIP DEVELOPMENT BENEFIT

If you are attending **full-time apprenticeship in-class training**, you may be eligible for funding through the Apprentice Development Benefit (ADB). Funding is tailored based on your situation to help with the following costs:



BASIC LIVING ALLOWANCE

If you do not qualify for Employment Insurance (EI) or if your EI rate is below \$500 per week, you may be eligible for a basic living allowance.



DEPENDENT CARE

You can get reimbursed for child care costs or for the care of other dependents.



COMMUTING

Get funding for the cost of daily commuting to and from training if you live more than 24km away.



TRAVEL AND OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION

If you need to relocate to attend training, ADB can help with transportation costs between your home and the training delivery agent.



LIVING-AWAY-FROM-HOME

Funding is available if you need to maintain a primary and temporary second residence during your training.



PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Support can be provided for costs necessary for in-class training that are not already provided by your training delivery agent. (e.g. assistive devices, accessible transportation costs).
