

VISITOR POLICY

CL2 Zone

Unauthorized entry is not permitted.

- Visitors are individuals who have not completed ACSI Health & Safety and Biosafety training.
- Visitors must be supervised by CL2-trained staff who are responsible for making sure the visitor follows all safety rules.
- Visitors must sign in and may require a Medical Surveillance Form.
- Contact Trina Budd, Licence Holder Representative, Manager-LCS, for guidance.

Health Restrictions

Visitors should **NOT** enter if they are:

- **Pregnant**
- **Allergic to lab chemicals**
- **Have a weakened immune system (immunodeficient or taking immunosuppressants)**
- **Have other medical conditions needing special precautions**



Clothing and Footwear Rules

All visitors entering the lab must wear appropriate:

- Shoes that fully cover the foot (top, toes and heels)
 - Long pants, skirts, or leggings with socks that cover your ankles and legs

 **Not Allowed:** Sandals, flip-flops, open-heel shoes, or shorts

After-Hours Emergencies

Facilities staff may enter the lab **after hours as directed**. Contact **Security** to provide access when approved. Please **scan the posted QR code** at the entrance to access emergency contact procedures and safety information.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)



PPE required upon entry:

- Lab coats, safety glasses, nitrile gloves

Check with Lab Technologist or Professor before entering active lab zones.



Additional Safety Notes

- Do not touch any materials or lab equipment unless explicitly instructed to
- Follow all posted signage and instructions from lab staff
- Report any incidents or exposures immediately to the staff
