On-Campus Job Search

There are three main websites that can be used to find on-campus positions:

1. [HireAC](#) (Select the Career & Employment tab from the left-hand menu)
2. [Algonquin College Careers Site](#) (Use the student filter)
3. [Students' Association](#)

You can also try visiting departments directly to see if they're hiring. [Student Recruitment](#), [Peer Tutoring](#), and [AC Hub](#) will often post student positions directly on their websites.

Please note: The best time to find on-campus jobs is during the first few weeks before and after a semester starts. However, keep checking back regularly for opportunities that come up throughout the semester.

Off-Campus Job Search

Use a variety of job search strategies to find the most opportunities:

- Search jobs online using a variety of job boards such as [HireAC](#), [Indeed](#), [Job Bank](#), [LinkedIn](#), [Charity Village](#), and the [Federal Student Work Experience Program](#) (FSWEP).
- Research companies of interest using business directories such as [Book of Lists](#), [Yellow Pages](#), and the LinkedIn Company Directory and professional associations related to your industry. Search for jobs directly on company websites.
- Check out stores and restaurants close to campus in College Square, along Merivale Road, or in local shopping centers like [Tanger Outlets](#), and the [Bayshore Shopping Centre](#). Approach companies in person to hand in a resume.
- Attend job fairs and employer sessions to connect with hiring managers. Find local events through the [HireAC Events & Workshops Calendar](#), [Peter's New Jobs](#), [Eventbrite](#), [LinkedIn](#) and on company websites.
- Make cold calls. Contact companies by phone or email to inquire about potential job opportunities.
