3. Business Arising

3.1 Policy SA03 Student Complaints

Ben Bridgstock advised that an early review of the policy has been conducted based upon feedback from Human Resources to streamline the complaint process and provide additional content for students and employees. The SA03 Policy has been reviewed to provide clear information and direction to students and staff regarding the complaint process. The purpose of this policy is to outline procedures and to provide a mechanism through which students can raise concerns about their academic experience, including services received.
