4. SA (Students Association) Priorities 2023-2024

Student Association President Abigail Soto Carvaja presented the <u>SA Priorities 2023-2024</u> to Council members.

Below are some highlights of each of the Students Associations Priorities:

- ✓ Priority 1 Housing: Increase the diversity of needs in student housing,
- Priority 2 Academics: Create standards, remove discrepancies, and refine Brightspace,
- Priority 3 Accessibility: Ensure accessibility services are consistently available throughout the calendar year,
- Priority 4 International: Add more International Advisors and move the International Education Centre to the Commons building. The relocation will accommodate a larger number of students,
- ✓ Priority 5 Sustainability: Create designated smoking and waste management areas,
- Priority 6 Transportation: The Students Association is currently in talks with Perth and Pembroke City Transit. The Student's Association is asking if more accessible and convenient transit for students can be created.

Following the presentation Committee members stressed the importance of ability training, a larger conversation needs to take place on creating uniform process for policy review, and a better system needs to be in place when dealing with aggressive situations ex. conflict resolution and mediation.
